**GOVERNMENT INSTITUTIONS PROVIDING SERVICES TO
INVESTORS PUT IN PLACE EFFECTIVE STRATEGIES**

The Tanzania Investment Centre (TIC) has continued to make rapid improvements for services to investors by strengthening the One Stop Facilitation Centre, with the Ministry, institutions and 11 Government departments providing accreditation, licensing and registration services to investors.

TIC Executive Director Dr. Maduhu Kazi said the improvements will help increase efficiency in providing investor services and strengthening the functioning of the facility as the order of the President of the United Republic of Tanzania Her Excellence, Samia Suluhu Hassan released in April, 2021 while swearing in the Secretary-Generals of the Ministry and Leaders of various Institutions.

In a continuation of making those improvements, Dr. Maduhu has held a joint session with the heads of 11 government institutions and departments providing services to the Facilitation Centre and noted that the improvement process continues to be undertaken.

"As you know, Her Excellence President issued instructions for improving services for investors, this session is a continuation of the implementation of those obligations, we started working for them and now we are continuing, the goal is to provide the best investment services" said Dr. Maduhu.

In the session, Dr. Maduhu has received a statement of measures that have been taken by each institution and relevant departments where those institutions have so far installed their electronic systems for issuing permits, licenses and registrations. The next electronic system improvements are integrating those systems to have a single window of registration services, permits and licenses to investors in the country.

Moreover; relevant institutions and departments continue to implement the instruction to complete all measures to address requests, including analyzing and decision-making at the relevant investor requests at the centre. These improvements are stated that it will allow investors investing in the country to access services in the short term and by using the lowest cost.

The Ministry, institutions and government departments providing services at the TIC's One Stop Facilitation Centre are the Prime Minister's Office (Department of Labor), Ministry of Land and Housing Development, (Immigration Department), Safety and Health Agency (OSHA), Tanzania Medicines and Medical Devices Authority (TMDA), Tanzania Revenue Authority (TRA), National Environmental Management Council (NEMC), The National Identification Authority (NIDA), Tanzania Bureau of Standards (TBS), Business Registration and Licensing Agency (BRELA) and TANESCO.
